

What Do I Bring to the test Session?

If you are not licensed, you need to bring:

- Your FCC Registration Number (FRN).
- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- A pen for signing the application.
- A pencil for marking the test answer sheet.
- Proof of a previous license used for element credit (see next page):
 - A Technician class license granted prior to March 21, 1987.
 - An expired General, Conditional, Advanced, or Amateur Extra class license.

If you are upgrading an existing license, you need to bring:

- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- The original and a photocopy of any CSCEs showing credit for elements already passed but not reflected in your current license.
- Proof of a previous license used for element credit (see next page):
 - o A Technician class license granted prior to March 21, 1987.
 - An expired General, Conditional, Advanced, or Amateur Extra class license.
- A pen for signing the application.
- A pencil for marking the test answer sheet.

If you are renewing an existing license, or are changing your name, contact information, or call sign on your existing license, you need to bring:

- A picture ID such as a driver's license or school ID.
- A pen for signing the application.

Acceptable Proof of Expired License used for Element Credit:

- A copy of an expired Technician class license granted prior to 21 Mar 1987 for Element 3 credit.
- A copy of an expired General class license, an expired Advanced class license, or an expired Amateur Extra class license for Element 3 credit.
- A copy of an expired Amateur Extra class license for Element 4 credit.
- A letter from the FCC indicating the applicant was previously granted a specific class of license and when the license was granted.
- A copy of the cover and applicable page from a Call Sign book showing the date of publication, the applicant's name, call sign, and class of license.
- A copy of an entry from the historical license database from QRZ.com.
