

## PIO – 2021 summary and January 2022

2021 started off with our meeting site closing their doors January 1 but we didn't miss a meeting as we found new place immediately.

The Club KD9LLH also has a two meter net on every Monday night for members and all hams wishing to participate.

Gary Fritz was appointed to the position of Director of Presentations. Gary's background in electronics and his technical knowledge of amateur radio resulted in very informational and interesting presentations. The club purchased all the necessary equipment for better audio and video both for the meetings and Zoom participants.

In October in search of setting up a public demonstration of amateur radio we conducted an investigation for RF in the River Walk Park In Jasper. It was discovered the RF was so high emitting from the adjacent power lines made this park un-usefull for our demonstration. We'll focus on public demonstrations in 2022 as a recruitment tool.
