QRM

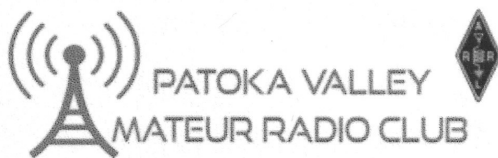
- July meeting is July 18.
